About your library:

- ◆ Children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ Library cards are **FREE**—get one! Replacement cards are \$5.00.
- ◆ Guest passes are available for computer use; photo ID is required.
- ◆ Material check out limit: 5 items for children and 10 items for adults.
- ◆ Books are due back three weeks after checkout and DVDs are due back one week after.
- ◆ Items checked out may be renewed in person, online, or by phone. Library card number is required.
- ◆ Fines must be paid in full before any family member can have checkout privileges.
- ◆ Please make sure your contact information is up to date.
- ◆ Library catalog is available online from any computer. Library has four designated “Catalog” computers in-house.
- ◆ Copy/Print prices start at \$0.15 each for black and white and \$0.75 each for color. Laminating prices start at \$0.50.
- ◆ We do not fax.
- ◆ Wifi is available 24/7.

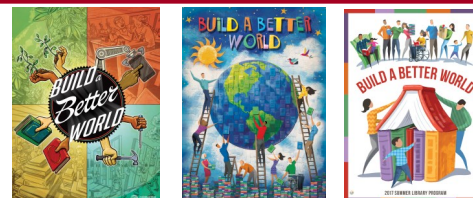

BUILD A BETTER WORLD! CHILDREN'S SUMMER READING PROGRAM: May 22—June 30

How the program works: Ages 2-11 Sign-up begins May 22. Adults may sign up readers or readers may sign up themselves. Readers will receive a reading log and prize 1. Picture book readers will receive a title log and write down book titles they read or that someone reads to them. Read at least one book per day. Chapter book readers will receive a time log and write how much time they read. Read at least 15 min. per day. In order to get a pool party pass, readers must check-in three additional times before the program ends. Readers check-in only once per week. Last day to check-in is June 30. Prizes are given in sequential order and are *not for sale*—they are rewards! We will not allow entrance into pool area if you did not completed the reading program.

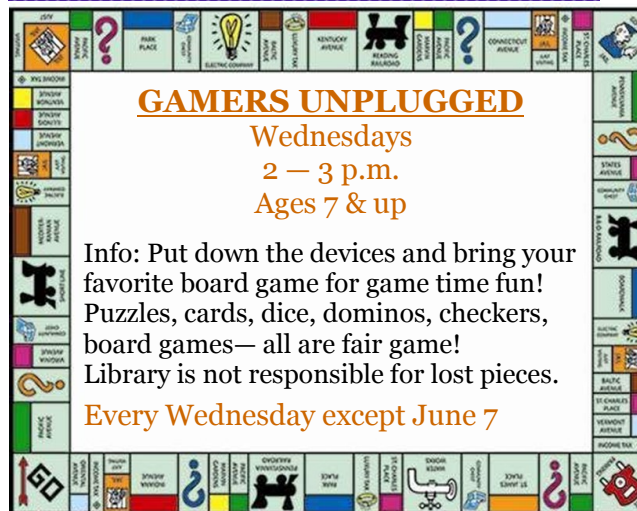
